


MEYBLUM & Fils: a family tradition






MEYBLUM & Fils Commitments

Production tools

- 2 bottling lines with 3000 and 8000 bottles / h with a pressurized printing room
- 3 labelling lines with a recovery line for flexibility in order management
- A total storage capacity of 60 000 Hl in thermo-regulated vats, ie 8 million bottles
